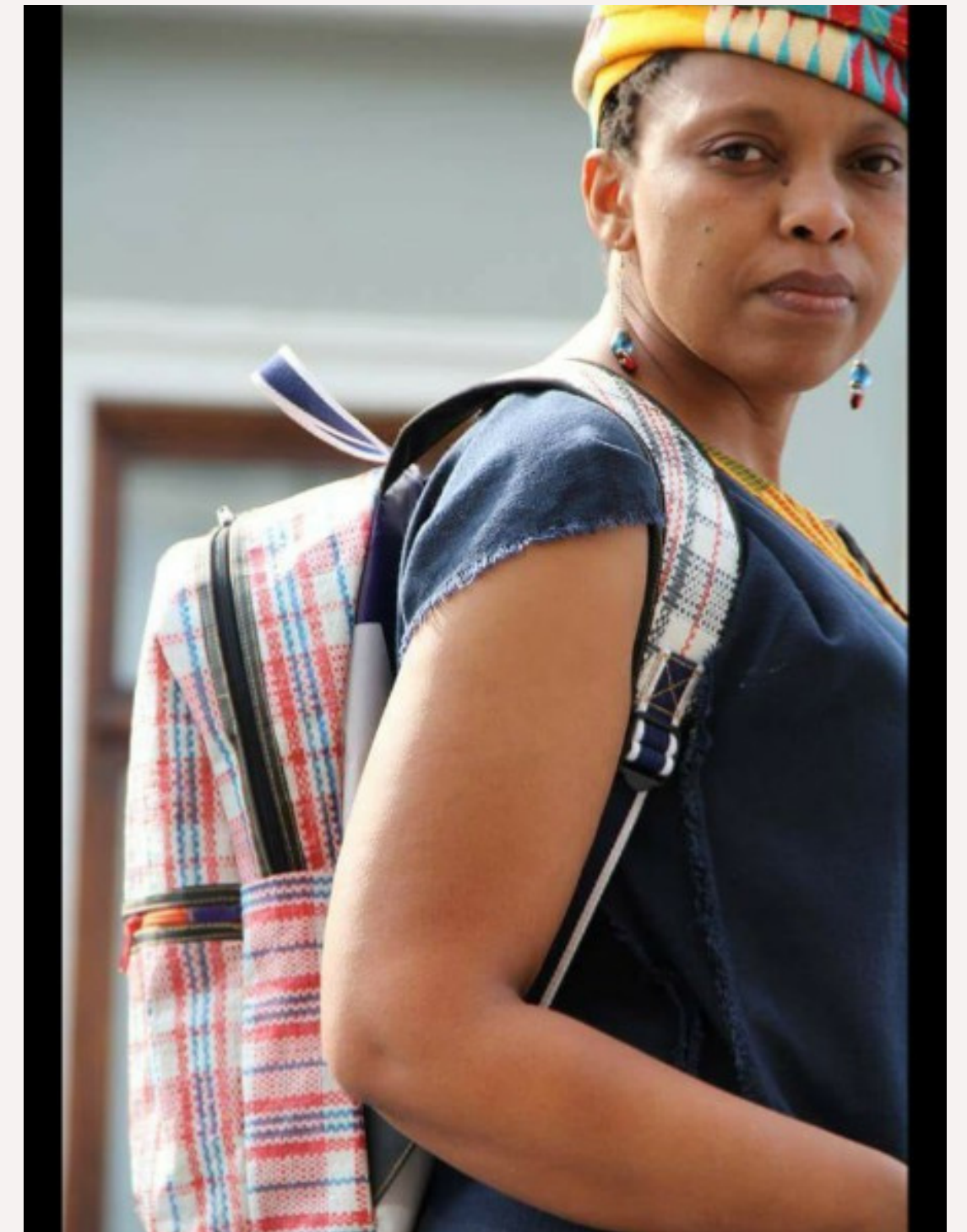
Some outlets we supply, both locally and internationally include;
