In weddings chisa Nyama is a great way to break the ice between both families, it allows them to interact and assist each other on the Barbecue stand and start sharing different ways of how to go about it, small laughters, teasing and deep talks echo amongst the groups who then break away into smaller Particles of people who seem to be jelling beyond the chisa nyama and find common interests In daily life's activities; Bond is finally created between both families and the over all task is complete closeness, comfort and Joy is in the Atmosphere.



On this tour we get to show case the different chisa nyama set ups in a city then Switch to a local township, we experience two different townships and one chisa nyama in the inner city. Each destination holds a certain culture of its own around how they act and interact with each other, the idea is to pay attention to how the gathering makes individuals of different spaces behave towards each other, the vibe changes the style and and taste too.
